the pre-entry price, the show secretary must receive all
documents required by August 9th (copy of registration
papers, negative Coggins less than 12 months old, Health
Certificate less than 30 days old for out of state horses,
copy of PFHA cards (amateur owner and professional),
copy of USEF cards (amateur owner and professional),
Entry Forms (both sides completed and signed). No back
number(s) will be issued until all paperwork is complete. A
signed open check must be left with the show secretary for
receipt of back number(s).

number(s) will be issued until all paperwork is complete.

**Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules
and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be
conducted and judged in accordance therewith.**

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows
them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they
reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of
any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles,
scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds
of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary
license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as
long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's
license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions
against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are
responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties
may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s),
and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the
remainder of the competition and charges being filed against
any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6.
Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for
individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
